# FUNCTIONAL ILLITERACY IN ROMANIA

Readers are not born, but they are educated.

Romania has the least developed book publishing market in Europe, and this has a negative effect on the development of society: the highest rate of unemployment is recorded among people with a low level of education.

Functional illiteracy is a phenomenon characteristic of people who attend or have attended a school, but they are incapable of making simple mathematical calculations, of understanding the ideas of a text, of making an argument, and of establishing transdisciplinary connections.

### What could be the solution to these problems?

Education, children's access to books appropriate to their age and reading together with adults, who could help them understand their mistakes, who could answer their questions, with whom to interact and who could urge them to activate their creativity and curiosity.



50%

Over 50% of adolescents live in rural areas, where there are no bookstores or properly equipped libraries.
Only 2% of them apply to colleges.


About 42% of Romanian students who are 15 years old are illiterate. They don't understand what they read and can not extract the main ideas from a text.

95%

95% of children who are stimulated by parents to read say that reading is important to success later in life.

At the same time, they believe that this activity would be easier and more useful if they could read books appropriate to their age and discuss it with other people.

Children who read have better results in all school subjects and their social skills are much more developed than those who do not read.

Our projects are based on the **BOOKS OF CHILDHOOD** collection, which includes masterpieces of universal literature retold as to be understood by children, thus offering them their first notions of general knowledge.

Also, we offer to children books that show remarkable professional paths: the heroes of these volumes can be policemen, chemists, sports champions facing challenges, but also internationally known artists or fashion designers.

### In every home

Many Romanian children don't have access to books. Many of them don't have a home library and no bookstore in the town where they live.

The problem is that without access to books, the children in the Romanian villages are always behind their colleagues from wealthier families, who read more.

We facilitate access to books for children in disadvantaged areas through donations and reading clubs

# Involvement in agricultural communities

Since 2015, with the support of Azomureş company, we have organised activities in areas where agriculture is perhaps the only chance for a better future.

Aware of the negative effects of the lack of education in any community, local entrepreneurs support us in organizing book donations and special events dedicated to reading.

## Interactive workshops and reading clubs

We bring together play and reading in every school and every family!

We challenge children to draw, compose a soundtrack, invent stories, write theater pieces, or make a character trial.





The introduction of artistic activities into the daily study program of children or the adaptation of the techniques borrowed from art for teaching have great results and make the learning process of children more efficient.

Participants in the architectural workshop starting from the novel *Notre-Dame de Paris* can discuss medieval architecture and make a replica of the famous Parisian cathedral.

At the same time, children become familiar with the specific culture of different cultures and develop a greater capacity for understanding diversity.

Participants in the theater workshop based on *the Myths of Ancient Greece* come in contact with certain aspects of Greek culture that are still current.



- The ability to understand what they are reading;
- The motivation to read;
- The inclination to think critically;
- The ability to familiarize themselves with the literary universe, which they naturally can relate to their own experience;
- Communication skills and teamwork;
- Memory and attention;

Depending on the specificity of each workshop, we can add:

learning and understanding basic concepts of art history, esthetic appreciation, understanding of essential narrative concepts such as cause and effect, action and reaction, character, persuasion.



How do you transform a book into a play?

What would Ulysses look like if he were a comic book character?

We show the children that every book is an adventure worth living!
We organize annually the biggest festival dedicated to reading in Romania - The NARATIV
Festival, an ample event that includes original and creative workshops, exploring different and fun ways to read and create stories.

**ENTERTAINING READING** 

Together with the children, we create a cartoon inspired by the *Odyssey*, we learn to conduct investigative journalism from books written by Jules Verne, we reinvent illustrated legends, we bring pros and cons in a character trial, we develop stories in different languages, we study the architecture of Notre-Dame Cathedral in Paris, we create a soundtrack for our favorite book, we play our favorite roles and we become directors in a spectacle of shadow theater.

We are helped by **pedagogues** who **coordinate activities** and encourage young people to have dynamic experiences that are different from those they have at school. Each workshop is based on a book created by **education specialists and child psychologists and whose scope is to overcome the difficulty of understanding the text.**


